



## Competition Information and Guidelines

**Supplies are provided for categories 1-6. For Category 7, only Batteries are provided, contestant must bring supplies to assemble a car.**

### **1. Freestyle** 9am-9:45am

- Contestants: Grades K-12<sup>th</sup>
- Time limit: 45 minutes

### **2. Speed Math Competition** 9:45am-10:15am

- Contestants: Grades 3<sup>rd</sup>- 12<sup>th</sup>
- Time limit: 30 minutes

### **3. Watercolor painting** 10:15am- 11am

- Contestants: Grades 3<sup>rd</sup>- 12<sup>th</sup>
- Time limit: 45 minutes

### **4. Math Word Problems** 11:10-11:30am

- Contestants: Grades 6<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup>
- Time limit: 20 minutes

LUNCH available to purchase 11:30am-12:15pm

### **5. Paper Plane** 12:15pm-12:30

- Contestants: Grades 6<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup>
- Time limit: 15 minutes

### **6. Building a bridge: Group (up to a total 5 participants)/Individual** 9am-12:30pm

Judging takes place at 12:30-1pm

- Contestants: Grades 6<sup>th</sup> -12<sup>th</sup>
- Time: 4 hours
- Building the bridge with popsicle sticks that can hold the maximum weight at the competition
- Requirements: at least 12 inches wide

### **7. Building a miniature motorized car: Group (up to a total of 5 participants)/Individual** 9am-12:30pm

ONLY BATTERIES ARE PROVIDED, BRING YOUR OWN SUPPLIES TO ASSEMBLE A CAR

Judging takes place at 1pm -1:30

- Contestants: Grades 6<sup>th</sup> -12<sup>th</sup>



- Time: 4 hours
- Building the car that can operate with the provided batteries. NO additional supplies are provided, bring your own supplies to assemble a car
- Requirements: at least 12 inches wide
