Since school and district funds are limited, and often restricted to specific expenditures, very little money is available to activities and projects that extend learning and support children outside of school time. For many children, the experiences they receive through GOT Kids are the only ones that enable them to see the world beyond their neighborhood. GOT Kids hopes to engage children in exciting learning activities that will spark interests and help them discover talents and skills. GOT Kids was also formed to support children who may need help with everyday needs that are essential for learning such as school supplies and clothing.


Mission

Fit Life Impact Program

GOT Kids partnered with the Lodi Hospital Foundation and Lodi Unified School District to develop a health and wellness program for children after school hours. Through a \$50,000 grant from the Community Foundation of San Joaquin, GOT Kids offered a comprehensive program that taught children about living a healthy lifestyle. The children learned about fitness, good eating habits, and careers in the health/fitness field. In addition, parents also learned about making healthy choices at the grocery store and how to help children stay active at home.





Michael David Family Foundation Science Day Camp

Thanks to the Michael David Family Foundation, GOT Kids offered a 3-day Science Day Camp in June for 60 children. The camp took place at Lodi Lake and included fun learning activities from the WOW Museum and the City of Lodi such as rocket launching, fly fishing, nature walks, and much more. Children told camp leaders that they can't wait for the next Day Camp. GOT Kids looks forward to expanding the program this June.







Art Show

In partnership with Lodi Unified School District, GOT Kids sponsored an art show and contest for students in grades 7-12. Over 200 entries were submitted and judged. All entries were on display for a weekend at the Elkhorn Golf Club. Special thanks to middle school and high school art teachers for helping students experience this event. Student artists expressed their appreciation to GOT Kids for giving them this opportunity. Several participants said this was the first time that they received recognition for a job well done.



My Books
